With only a few days remaining before I leave for Ghana, I want to recap some information for you by answering some questions I have been hearing from some of you in recent weeks.

What is your support status?

Just days ago, additional pledges came in, bringing me to full-support status. This means that I now have the monthly financial pledges recommended by HCJB Global for service in Ghana! I appreciate the faithful pledged support as well as the special gifts that are being given. Also, so many of you pray regularly for me. Prayer is such an important part of any support team. Without this crucial support, I would not be on my way to Ghana. Even though I have reached my support goal, additional donations are always appreciated as financial needs and circumstances can change quickly on the mission field.

What will you be doing over there?

My official position in Ghana will be "Project Manager". This leaves the door wide open for me to be involved in a variety of projects that HCJB Global might get involved in. Mostly, my responsibilities will lie in radio planting. As we get requests from ministries within the Sub-Saharan Africa region for new radio stations, I will help facilitate the projects. This may mean anything from working out a budget to actually going to the site and working on the radio station. I will also work with many of our partners with existing radio stations in our region who need assistance with equipment upgrades or replacement. A secondary part of my job will be integrating health care and media initiatives in our region. One example of this type of work will be installing water wells for communities in Africa.

What is your schedule?

June 4th through the 7th, I will be attending a well drilling course in Holland, Michigan. The training focuses on drilling and maintaining water wells for communities in developing countries. I will then travel back to Bluffton, Indiana where I will spend my remaining time before leaving for Ghana on June 11th. I have been assigned to live in Ghana for two years, though I am planning on returning to the U.S. for a short time next May.

How will you keep in contact?

While in Ghana, I will continue to send out my prayer letters by mail. I will also continue to post updates on my website. My contact information is at the bottom of this page. For anyone with Skype, my ID is jeremy.maller. I would like to hear from you!

How can we pray for you?

Please be in prayer for me as I adjust and acclimate to my new culture. There will be many differences and challenges I will encounter. Also, please pray as I travel to different locations in Africa. In addition, I want to share a praise note that I have housing arranged through the rest of 2008.

I am looking forward to these next two years with anticipation and excitement. God is doing great things in Africa! Thank you for your vital part in this ministry.
